

Cooking Matters Core Evaluation Summary

Evidence Base

Cooking Matters Core is a set of lessons that was developed throughout 2022 and 2023 in collaboration with Cooking Matters participants and partners. The content is grounded in historic Cooking Matters curricula and adheres to the 2020-25 USDA Dietary Guidelines for Americans. It has not undergone research testing at this time. Utilizing E-Surveys

The participant survey for Cooking Mattes Core was designed using a panel of experts who determined its alignment with SNAP-Ed evaluation indicators. The included questions included in the survey were drawn from previously validated surveys. The survey then underwent cognitive testing with the assistance of former Cooking Matters participants. Unfortunately, pilot testing in a program setting was not completed before the discontinuation of the Cooking Matters program. While the survey is not fully validated it can still be of value in capturing pre- and post-program behaviors among participants.
